 General rule for madhwas is Perform Ekadashi / Dwadashi shraddha on Dwadashi observance day. Shraddha Thithis on Athiriktha Ekadashi and Shravana Dwadashi days have to be performed on the Parane (next) day.  
 Sometimes Ekadashi shraddha thithi occurs on a Viddha / Dashami day, Dwadashi shraddha thithi on Ekadashi observance day. In both the cases, performing Shraddha on the Dwadashi parane day is the general rule.  
 One school of thought is that Ekadashi shraddha can be performed on Dashami day if the shraddha thithi is Ekadashi. Some mutts do not agree with this contention. Concerned persons may ascertain the date from their mutts/purohit.

**Vayu Purana's Uma Samhita** Shlokas 154 to 168 gives details of Sundara Kanda sargas to be recited for achieving specific purposes. The **41st sarga** describes "**Distruction of Ashoka Vana**". This sarga's recital has been prescribed "**To gain the desired Object**".

This has been provided for the readers' use. For further details readers are advised to refer to Vayu Purana itself. However, its summary has been published in the book titled Srimad Valmiki Ramayane Sundara Kanda in devanagari published by LIFCO, Chennai.

## Mahalaya Paksha

A period of 15 days from Bhadrapada Krishna Prathama to Amavasya is called Pitru Paksha or Mahalaya Paksha or Paksha Masa. In case Kanya masa is also present, it is considered special. (Kanya masa is not the rule.)

### Speciality of Paksha Shraddha

During Kala Shraddha (the Death day of Father/Mother), Father, Grandfather, GreatGrandfather or Mother, her Mother-in-law, her Mother-in-law are called and Pindas given. During Paksha Shraddha Pindas are given to;

1. Father, Grandfather, GreatGrandfather
2. Mother, her Mother-in-law, her Mother-in-law
3. Step Mother
4. Mother's Father, his Father, his Father
5. Mother's Mother, her Mother-in-law, her Mother-in law
6. Wife
7. Son, his Wife, Grandchildren
8. Daughter, her Husband and Children
9. Brothers, their Wives and Children
10. Sisters, their Husbands and Children
11. Father's Brothers, their Wives and Children
12. Father's Sisters, their Husbands and Children
13. Maternal Uncles, their Wives and children
14. Mother's Sisters, their Husbands and Children
15. Father-in-law, Mother-in-law
16. Wife's Brothers, their Wives and Children
17. Wife's Sisters, their Husbands and Children
18. Vidya Guru, his Wife
19. Family Priest, his Wife
20. Shishya (Disciple)
21. Friends

\*\*\*\* Only those who have passed away

### Reserved Days during Mahalaya Paksha

**Navami – Avidhava Navami:** Shraddha for Ladies whose Husbands are alive is performed by her children on this day.

**Ekadashi** being a fasting day, No Paksha is performed.

**Dwadashi – Yathinam Dwadashi:** For those in the family who have taken up Sanyasa, their children perform Shraddha on this day.

**Chathurdashi – Shastradi Hatha/Ghatha Chathurdashi** is reserved for those who have died due to accident or war. Their children perform Shraddha on this day.

On these four days Paksha shraddha is not to be done. Even if Yathinam Dwadashi / Ghatha Chathurdashi is performed, Paksha Shraddha has to be performed.

If Kala Shraddha (the Death day of Father/Mother) is during the Paksha period, Paksha Shraddha is to be performed after the Kala Shraddha. If the Karthru's wife is in her period, Paksha Shraddha cannot be performed. In such an event or any other obstacle, Paksha can be performed till Ashwayuja Shukla Panchami.

### Mahalaya Gounakala

Thula masa (generally from October 17 to November 15) is called Mahalaya Gounakala. Paksha can be performed during this period by those who could not perform during the Paksha masa period. There are no reserved days during this period. Avidhava Navami, Yathinam Dwadashi and Ghata Chathurdashi cannot be performed during this period.

### Shraddhadhikari

Persons who have lost their father are Shraddhadhikaris. Also called Karthrus. In the year of Father's death, Paksha Shraddha, Ghatha Chathurdashi, Darsha Shraddha and Kshetra Vidhis (Shraddha performed in Sacred places during visit) are not to be performed. Similarly, in the year of death of Mother (as a person with Husband alive), Avidhava Navami is not to be performed.

### Who should perform Mahalaya Paksha Shraddha and Why?

Shraddhadhikaris performing Paksha Shraddha are bestowed with Good progeny by Father, Wealth of Cows by Grandfather and Wealth by GreatGrandfather and in general Jnana (Knowledge), Bhakthi (Devotion) and Vairagya (Detachment). For persons not performing Paksha Shraddha, curse is given. Their curse denies progeny.

It is said, lord Yama sends Pithrus to Bhooloka during Pithru Paksha for them to enjoy the Shraddha performed by their descendants. Pithrus wait in the descendants houses till fulfilment or end of Pithru Paksha / Mahalaya Gounakala. If not fulfilled, they curse the descendants and return.

### Amavasye and Importance of Ellu (Sesame)

Abhimani devathe of Ellu is Soma (Chandra). Pithruloka (Abode of Pithrus) is above Chandra. Marks on the Moon are the food to Pithrus. Hence, Ellu the favourite of Chandra is also the favourite of Pithrus.

On Earth, 24 hours make a day. For Chandra Earth's 15 days is Daytime and 15 days is Nighttime, thus making Earth's 1 month equal to 1 day of Chandra. Period of 15 days from Shukla Ashtami to Krishna Ashtami is Night time for Pithrus and the following period of 15 days from Krishna Ashtami to Shukla Ashtami is Day time for Pithrus. Therefore Amavasye represents the mid day for Pithrus. That is why Ellu Tharpana on Amavasye day is very important.

### Dharbhe's Importance

Once, Garuda brought Amrutha from Devendra in order to save his mother Vinutha from the mother of all serpents Kadru. He asked Vinutha to take bath and placed the Amrutha vessel on the Dharbhe grass. In the meantime, Devendra took away the Amrutha vessel, and while taking, spilled a drop of Amrutha on the Darbhe grass. Thus the Dharbhe grass has become pure and sacred called Pavithra.

**Missed Shraddhas**

Kala shraddhas (the Death day of Father/Mother) missed due to Ashoucha (both Jatha and Mrutha) is to be performed immediately after the Ashoucha period. Kala Shraddhas missed due to unforeseen circumstances (not Ashoucha) are to be performed in the immediate Krishna paksha Ashtami or Amavasya.

Avidhava Navami, Yatinam Dwadashi and Ghata Chaturdashi, if missed due to Ashoucha are lost and nothing needs to be done.

Masika Shraddhas (Monthly Shraddhas during the first year of death), if missed due to Ashoucha are lost and nothing needs to be done. This rule is not applicable to the First Annual Shraddha which comes under the First category.

Some people perform Vimoksha (Shraddha on the last day of the first year of death), sometime during the year of their father/mother's death, in order to perform their daughter's marriage during the same year. This is just a permission for the marriage and the remaining Masika Shraddhas have to be performed on the due dates.

Paksha Shraddha should not be missed due to any reason. Therefore an alternative period of One whole month (Thula Masa) called Mahalaya Gounakala has been provided.

**Deshabedha (Locational Difference) Ekaadashi**

*Bhagavatha/Vaishnava Ekaadashi observance is decided based on the rule that **Dashami should have ended before Arunodaya** (96 minutes period preceding Sunrise).*

***Sunrise occurs at different times of the same day at different places. Dashami ends around Arunodaya in a maximum of about three times in a year (In some years No such occasion occurs.)***

*In such occasions, Ekaadashis will have to be observed on **different days in different places** basis. **This is due to geographical/natural reasons only and Mutts calculations\*/practices are not the cause.***

*However, this Deshabedha is practiced in Uttaradi Mutt only.*

*In other mutts, the later day of the two different days is observed as Ekaadashi at all places.*

*Those who observe Ekaadashi may ascertain the dates in their Mutt.*

*Few Udupi mutts are using Drigganitha Panchangam for day to day use. Sometimes their Ekaadashi could be on a different day.*

*Smartha Ekaadashi is based on Ekaadashi thithi at the time of sunrise.*

**General Information about Muhurthas**

**Uttarayana, the best**

**Uttarayana** is the best period for any Muhurtha.

Panchangas are expected to indicate muhurthas for the months of Chaitra, Vaishakha, Jyeshtha, Magha and Phalguna only, which generally corresponds to Uttarayana.

However, during Dakshinayana, Margashira and Kartheeka masas are the best.

**Preferred Slot of Upanayana**

For Upanayana, the period from Shukla Panchami to Krishna Panchami is considered the most preferred.

**Ashada / Pushya Masas**

Ashada Masa is generally considered a taboo. However if Meena masa co exists it is considered acceptable.

Similarly Pushya masa is also considered a No Muhurtha masa. However the period when Dhanur masa coexists only is a No muhurtha period.

These have been considered while listing the muhurthas in this table.

**Asthas of Guru / Shukra**

Gurubala is very essential for the function to take place. Shukra is considered the planet indicating marriage. Hence Shukrabala is very important.

However, it is said that Guru Astha period is not suitable for Rugvedis, Shukra Astha period is not suitable for Yajurvedis and Bhouma Astha period is not suitable for Samavedis.

The rule is applicable for Upakarma also.

**Madhwas**

Madhwas do not fix Dashami, Ekadashi and Dwadashi as muhurthas - the three days are considered as Haridinas.

However, in exceptional circumstances, Dashami can be considered for Vivaha only (exclusive vivaha and not the subsequent function (Nisheka) in the night).

During Child marriage days, this question did not arise.

**Lagna Thyajya**

Lagnas for different muhurthas has been indicated in the table. Each of these Lagna's duration is roughly 2 hours.

However, One-third of the duration is called Thyajya meaning "To be discarded". The thayajya details are: First one third in case of Mesha, Vrushabha, Kanya and Dhanus lagnas, Second one third in case of Mithuna, Simha, Thula and Kumbha lagnas, Last one third in case of Karkataka, Vrushchika, Makara and Meena lagnas.

Nakshatra Thayajya for each day has been given in the Panchanga.

**Consult an Astrologer**

The given muhurthas are general in nature. These may be best suited as also not suitable for different individuals. Consulting a learned Astrologer with the individuals horoscope / nakshatra will determine the suitability.

### Ashoonya Shayana Vrata

This vrata is for non separation of couple.  
Vrata involves Shodashopachara pooja in the evening to Pratimas of Lakshmi and Narayana placed on a new bed. Bhojana is after Chandra Darshana. Vrata is on Krishna Dwitheeyas of Ashada, Shrawana, Bhadrpada and Aswina masas (beginning in Ashada and ending in Aswina).  
After completion of vrata, the new bed and pratimas have to be given away as Daana to an eligible couple.

Shloka for this Vrata:

### Current Day

For counting Impurity (Ashoucha) period due to Birth and Death the extent of Current day (on the Day of occurrence) is required. First 5/8 parts of the Rathrimana (night time – sunset to sunrise) is counted as part of the Current day and the rest as Next day. For a notional Sunrise of 6 am and Sunset of 6 pm, upto 1:30 am is considered as Current Day. This also means, the current day is from previous 1:30 am.

However for Rajaswala (Menses) nirnaya, first 2/3 of the night time is considered as part of current day, in which case 2:00 am would be the cutoff point.

For **Washington's** Sunrise and Sunset data which varies widely, a standard time cannot be set as above. Cutoff time given as 1:30 am above varies from 2:13 to 3:27. As most of the times it is after 2:45 am, may be 2:45 am can be safely used as a Thumb rule.

Similarly, for Rajaswala purposes, cutoff time varies from 2:50 to 4:00. As most of the times it is after 3:30 am, 3:30 am could be used as a Thumb rule.

### Tharabala

Tharabala is a way of checking the suitability of a chosen time for the person. With the person's birth nakshatra as 1 count till the nakshatra of the the chosen perid (Day and Time). The serial number obtained (notice that both the nakshatras - person's and the chosen period's - are included in the count) is divided by 9. The remainder indicates the Tharabala (literally the strength of the chosen period). The explanations for the remainders are given below the table.

**Usage:** Look for the person's nakshatra in the column on the left or right. Choose the required period's nakshatra in the top or bottom row. Read the result. The remainder after dividing by 9 is given. Result 6 which is the best possible is shown in bold.

**Thara Shanthi:** In unavoidable circumstances, when the Tharabala is 1(Janmathare), Shaka (Vegetables) daana, 3 (Vipaththare) Jaggery daana, 5 (Prathyakthare) Salt daana, 7 (Naidhanathare) Ellu (Sesame), Silver, Gold and Clathes daana will eliminate the dosha of Tharabala.

**Paschimadhanyadhipathi is Guru:** Brahmins will engage themselves in Yajnas. Cows milk yield will increase. Good rainfall ensures plenty of foodgrains.

**Arghyadhipathi (Incharge of Prices) is Bhouma:** Rain with wind. Agricultural yield and welfare of people is little.

**Meghadhipathi (incharge of Clouds) is Bhouma:** strong winds, less rain, and price fall occur. Plants yielding red grains grow.

**Rasadhipathi (Incharge of Liquids) is Chandra:** Cows will yield good quantity of milk. Brahmins will be engaged in Yajna and yagas.

**Neerasadhipathi (Incharge of Solids) is Shani:** Price of Iron, Black

Till and all Black grains will increase.

**Thamo megha:** Looks like yielding heavy rain, looks fearful, mixed with thunder. Results in continuous rain in sea area.

**Guru in Meena rashi** (From 13/4/2022 onwards) Kings will give up hatred towards one another. Kalinga and Vanga and Wrong doers will suffer. Earth will be beautiful with flowers, fruits and best plants. [Ganga sannidhana in River Pranchi (Tapti)].

**Guru in Kumbha rashi** (Upto 13/4/2022) Kings will give up hatred towards one another. Kalinga and Vanga and Wrong doers will suffer. Earth will be beautiful with flowers, fruits and best plants. [Ganga sannidhana in River Bheemarathi]

**Shani in Makara Rashi:** (Upto 29/4/2022 AND 11/7/2022 to 17/1/2023) There will be fear, rise in prices of plant produce and plentiful rain. Regions of Dasharma, Yavanas as also Priests, Brahmins, Doctors and Kings will meet destruction.

**Shani in Kumbha Rashi:** (From 29/4/2022 to 11/7/2022 AND 17/1/2023 onwards) Less rainfall. Rulers will experience fear. Plants will get destroyed. Poets, Doctors and Cashiers will experience lot of fear.

**Makara sankramana** occurs on 14<sup>th</sup> January 2023 at 15:25 Hrs. At that time Sayahna kala, Pushya masa, Krishna Paksha, Ashtami, Chitra Nakshatra, Sukarman yoga and Balava Karana exists.

**Makara Sankranthi Purusha Lakshana:** Rakshasi is the name – indicates Peeda to Chandalas. Bathes in Shuddha Jala, sitting on Vyaghra(Tiger) holding Khadga Ayudha as weapon in hand, wearing Raktha (Blood Red) blouse, Raktha (Blood Red) clothes, smeared Chandana (Sandal) essence, wearing Mudra jewellery, holding a Raktha (Blood Red) umbrella, uses JaveGodhi (Yava) grains, wearing Jaji (Jathi) flowers, holding Banana (Kadali) phala, holding Silver (Rajatha) vessel, eating Curd Rice (Dugdha). Is maiden (Kumari) aged, belongs to Serpents (Sarpa) Clan, has a Angry (Krodha) face, is in a Enjoying (Bhoga awastha) state, looking West(Pashchima) and is moving towards South (Dakshina).

**Phala:** All items used by the Sankranthi purusha will either become costly or perish. **Praveshakala phala:** (Pashunam) Peeda to Vaishyas.

**Time slots** have been given on the left. These vary from month to month. 11th of the month has been considered for computing them. The range of the time slot has to be read as the time range between one row and the immediate next row. For the last row it is between that and the first row.

This **Chandramana Panchangam** is calculated for **Washington DC** (77°-02' West Longitude, 38°-54' North Latitude) based on **Surya Siddhantha** system. The end times of Thithi, Nakshatra, Yoga and Karana are given in **Eastern Standard Time** (with adjustment for Day light savings) and as such are applicable to all places.
